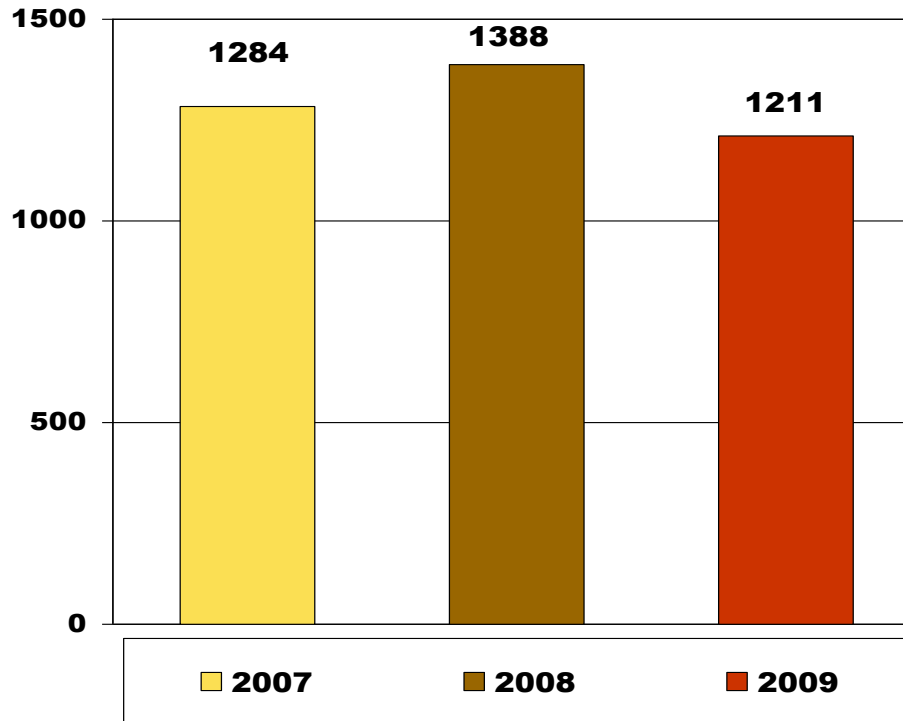
# Crime Statistics

- The statistics in this report are preliminary numbers; the final numbers may vary slightly
- The DPD switched to a more enhanced Incident Based Reporting (IBR) system in 2006
- As a result, the SBI can make adjustments to previous monthly reports, which was not done in the past
- The DPD statistics will be re-run on a quarterly basis to make any necessary adjustments (unfounded cases, justifiable homicides, case clearances etc.)



# Violent Crime

2007 - 2009

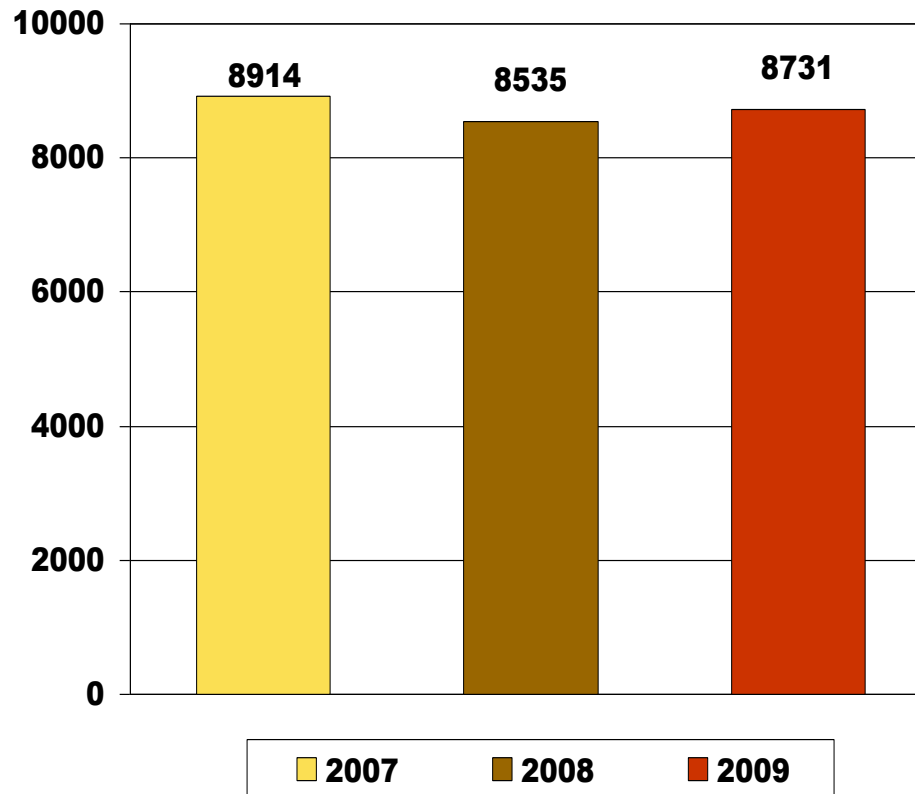


- Violent crime was down 13 percent compared to YTD 2008
- Violent crime was down 6 percent compared to YTD 2007
- YTD violent crime was at a 3-year low



# Property Crime

January – September  
2007 - 2009

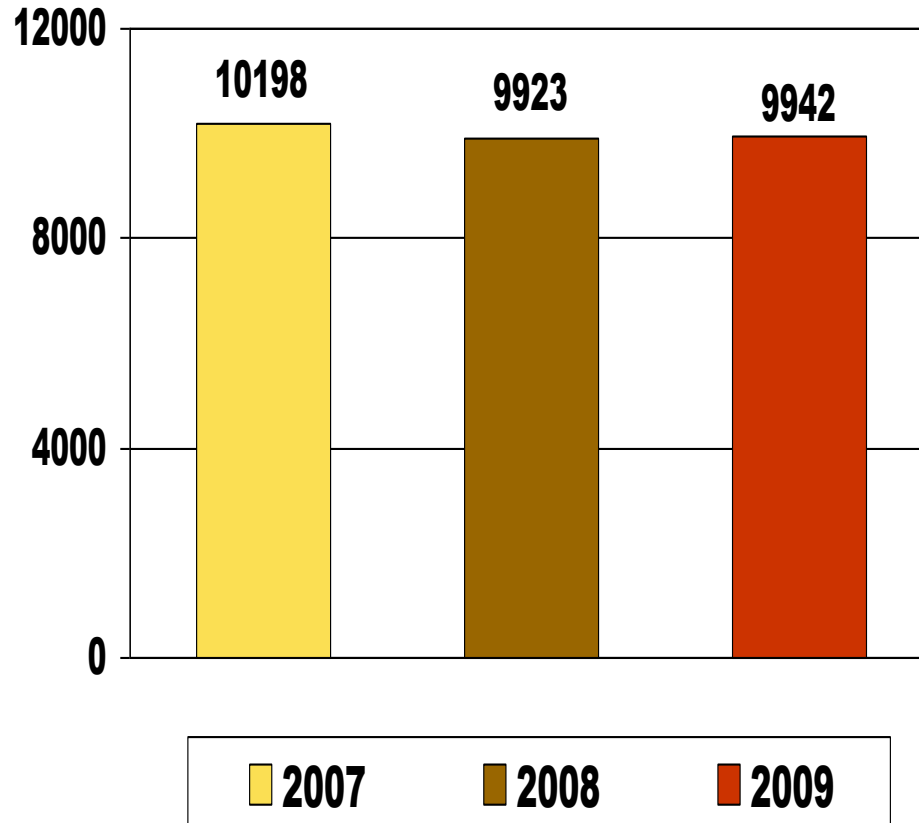


- Property crime is up 2 percent from YTD 2008
- Property crime is down 2 percent from YTD 2007



# All Index Crime

January – September  
2007 – 2009



- Overall index crime is up less than 1 percent compared to 2008 YTD

- Overall index crime dropped 3 percent compared to 2007 YTD

- 10 Vacant (2%)

## Civilian Staffing

September 30, 2009

- 120 Civilian Positions
- 114 Filled (95%)
- 6 Vacant (5%)



# Response Times Priority 1 Calls

## FY 09-10 Target

- Respond to Priority 1 calls in 6:5 minutes or less
- 52% response time less than 5 minutes

## FY July-Sept

- Average response time – 6.3 minutes
- 50.92% response time less than 5 minutes
- 1,846 Priority 1 Calls for Service
